Admission and Summer Session Information

- **Summer 2026 Schedule:**
 - The start date is June 8, with sessions Monday-Friday through July 10, with no session on June 19 or July 3.
 - Our end of Summer 2026 Celebration will be on Saturday, June 11, 2026
- **Transportation:**
 - Horizons will provide bus service only to families with multiple students in our program. Families will drop off students at the school where the youngest student attends. Otherwise, families will drop off and pick up students at their school location.
- **Admissions:**
 - We are accepting applications for Rising 1st (current Kindergarten) through Rising 12th Grade (current 11th grade) for Returning Students, New Siblings, Summer 2025 Waitlist Students, and New Students (in this priority order). You will receive emails for admission decisions for each student.
- **Online Application (Required):**
 - Your username will be your current email address; personal email addresses are requested, as business email may block Horizons ABQ messages.
 - Go to <https://horizons.my.site.com/s/> (online enrollment is available in Spanish and English)
 - Returning or New Sibling Students: Parent/Guardian must log in using the same email used for Summer 2025 enrollment. If needed, please request a new password at the enrollment link above. If you have multiple or changed emails, contact Dennis at dshaulis@horizonsalbuquerque.org.
 - New Students: If you are a parent of a New Student, you will need to set up an account on our online application system, which can be used for multiple student applications. You will need to complete an online application for each student.
 - Using a computer or mobile device with internet access, open a web browser and navigate to <https://horizons.my.site.com/s/>.
 - Click on "**Sign Up**" and complete the form. Once you have completed the form, go back to the Login page <https://horizons.my.site.com/s/> to log in with the Username and Password you just created.
- **A complete application for admission must meet the following criteria:**
 - **Family Household income meets eligibility for free or reduced-price meals as determined by the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines.**
 - The student does not have any special education needs. We do not have the staffing capacity to support these students adequately.
 - Students would benefit from intensive academic support (2/3 of our scholars perform below grade level in reading and/or math upon enrollment in the program).
 - Parents or Guardians can make a long-term commitment to meaningful participation and engagement throughout the program. Once students are accepted into the program, they will continue to receive a scholarship through their senior year of high school if they have maintained excellent attendance and family participation.
 - Full online application completed and Payment of the \$20 registration fee (for each new student only)
 - For all students:
 - A copy of the most recent progress report and a completed [Computer/Internet App Use Consent](#) form for each student
 - A parent/guardian signed commitment page from our Horizons ABQ Handbook (will be emailed to parent/guardian after online application is submitted)

 - A completed ECECD enrollment
